An actuary by training, Claude was the inaugural President & CEO of the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan. From 1990 to his retirement in 2007, he oversaw Teachers' development into one of the world's leading pension plans with more than \$100 billion in net assets, an innovative investment program, and outstanding services to more than 250,000 plan members. Before 1990, Claude spent 25 years as a senior financial executive with Metropolitan Life in Canada and the US, heading the Company's operations in Canada from 1986 to 1990. He co-founded the Canadian Coalition for Good Governance in 2002. Claude has served on many Boards. He holds a BA from the U of Montreal, a B.Comm. from Laval University, and honorary doctorates from York University and HEC-Montreal. He is a Fellow of the Society of Actuaries and the Institute of Corporate Directors. He is an Officer of the Order of Canada and the National Order of Québec.
